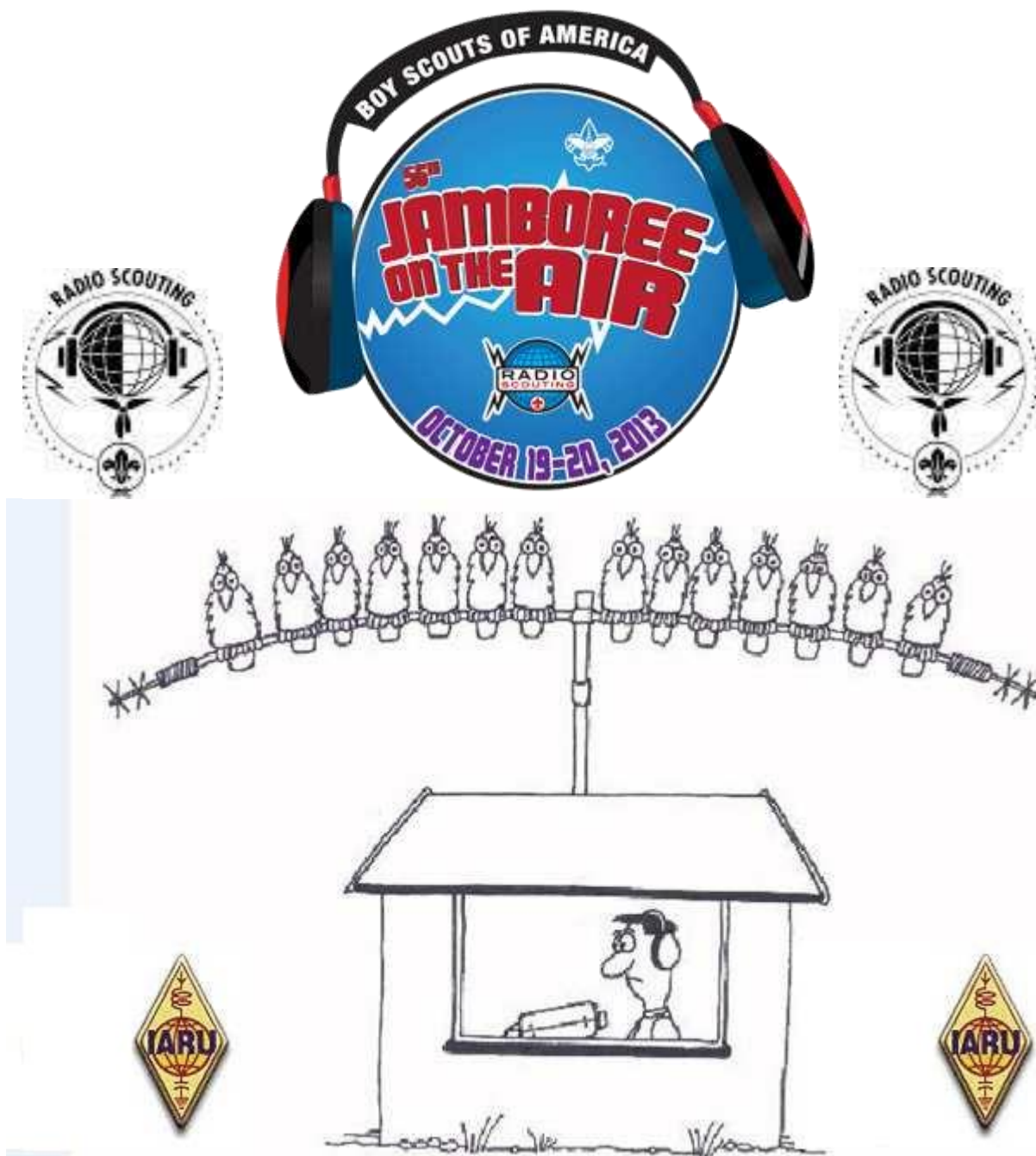


A JOTA-guideline for scouts and radioamateurs who working Jamboree / JOTA

What is JOTA/Jamboree

Scouts on the Air?

When the scout are going on the air with their radiooperator controller or radioamateur, they should be given an A4 papersheet with following filled out information:

Name spelled into Phonetic alfabeth. Like ANNE Alfa-november-november-alfa

Age

Scoutgroup

Hobbies

Jota puzzle code.

10.1 The Phonetic Alphabet

Make instruction and tour the scouts about the phonetic alphabet in English or their native language. So they are prepared to speak local and English language. For those who didn't try, it's very important to slow and spell their name clear and loud.

The receiving station can copy you better with this system with phonetic language in international society.

- 1 – one
- 2 – two
- 3 – tree
- 4 – fower
- 5 – fife
- 6 – six
- 7 – seven
- 8 – eight
- 9 – niner
